*Caribbean-Pacific Island Mobility Scheme*

## What exactly is CARPIMS II?

The CARPIMS II Project is a cooperation and mobility programme in the area of Higher Education, Co-ordinated by The University of the West Indies and funded by the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency ([EACEA](#)) of the European Union (EU).

The project is designed to facilitate the movement of Masters students, PhD students and Staff between selected National Universities in the Caribbean and Pacific regions as a means of building capacity and encouraging socioeconomic development in each region.

Staff Members from both Academic and Administrative streams can apply for 1 month staff mobility scholarships at one of the Ten CARPIMS 2 Consortium Partners. These scholarships can facilitate the:

- Building capacity by facilitating specialist training for staff at partner institutions
- Advancement of knowledge through collaborative teaching and research

### What the Staff Mobility Covers?

All expenses related to the staff mobility will be covered by CARPIMS 2, including:

- Airfare to and from the Host Institution
- Allowance of EUR1,000 paid to the staff scholar to cover living expenses during the one month mobility
- Travel and Health Insurance coverage for the duration of the mobility
